### SIGN BOARDS

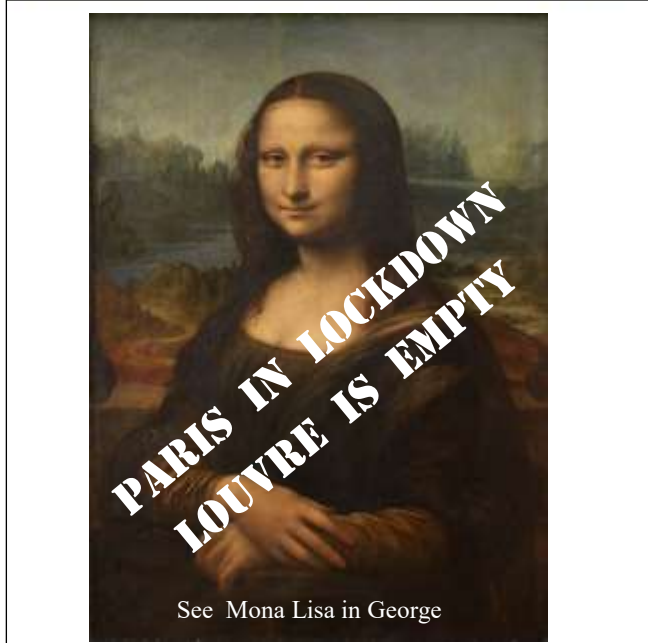
The Committee gave permission for funds to be released to make some versatile signs to be placed near or around the Museum for the duration of exhibitions.
